Ramakrishna Mission,

- Dibrugarh, Assam (India) is a branch center of Ramakrishna Math and Mission, Belur, Howrah, India
- 'For one's own spiritual liberation and for the well-being of the world'- this is the aim and ideal of Ramakrishna Mission, a spiritual organization of international repute, having its headquarters at Belur Math, Howrah, West Bengal, India.
- This was founded by patriotic saint Swami Vivekananda in May 1897 for the propagation of Sri Ramakrishna's spiritual teachings and for the dissemination of the rich cultural heritage of India
- A group of people inspired with the ideal of service preached by the great Swami Vivekananda established Sri Ramakrishna Seva Samity, Dibrugarh in the year 1928.
- Samity had served all the way in the field of Spirituality, Culture, Education and Medical till year 18th February 2018, when it was merged in the Ramakrishna Mission and got its new identity as

- The literacy rate of Assam is below the national average of 74.04% according
 to the last census held in our country in the year 2011. Among the tea garden
 settlements this literacy rate goes far below the average State level and
 people out there trapped into the perpetual cycle of poverty.
- Ramakrishna Mission, Dibrugarh as its one regular service activity runs Maa Sarada Kindergarten to serve 75 kids from lower income group of Dibrugarh city.
- Ashram has been carrying out financial support to students under the project "Vivekananda Scholarship Scheme" (for Poor but Meritorious Students) since the year 2019-20.
- Till the year 2020-21, we supported 10 students annually. This year 2021-22 Ramakrishna Mission, Dibrugarh has offered one-time scholarship to 20 students. Our vision for financial Year 2022-23 is to extend this service to 40 students from Corona affected families; specially for the students who has lost one of the parents or earning members of the family.
- This proposal is aiming to fulfil our vision on supporting 100 such students through "Vivekananda Scholarship Scheme" of Ramakrishna Mission, Dibrugarh, Assam within the span of next three fiscal years. The inclusive approach will be adopted to support students for their financial, moral and all-round development of personality.



- Education transforms lives and breaks the cycle of poverty that traps so many children. In Assam, a vast number of primary and secondary school children from tea garden settlements are not in the classroom because of revelling Socio-economical condition.
- In keeping with our mission to educate Tea garden children, this scholarship scheme has been started to ensure children regardless of cast, creed, gender or circumstances—have access to a quality education in school level.
- This scheme enables impoverished children to go to school while living at home with their family. Many parents cannot afford the uniform and school supplies necessary to keep their children in school. Ramakrishna Mission, Dibrugarh provides enough money to give the children uniforms, book bags and supplies.
- We would support on annual basis a total of 100 students in Dibrugarh and near about schools. Rs. 7,500/- to 10,000/- per year per student to keep an impoverished student in school.





CURRENT PROGRAM

Beneficiaries:

Poor but meritorious students of Secondary and Higher secondary School.

Selection Procedure:

Monastic in-charge of the Service activity along with local Devotee volunteers personally visiting to the beneficiaries' school and place of living and survey the socio-economic situation of students.

Place of Activity: Dibrugarh City and adjoining area.

Scholarship Conferring procedure:

On National Youth Day i.e. 12th January, birthday of Swami Vivekananda, Ramakrishna Mission, Dibrugarh organises one Youth Convention. Scholarship bank cheques are handover in the name of one of the parents to the selected students on the same day.

Volume of Scholarship:

Each student got one-time Scholarship annually of Rs. 5,000/-

Number of beneficiaries:

Total number of beneficiaries served 20 Students.

FOR YEAR 2024-25


Proposed amount: Rs. 10 Lakh
